Mayor Bollwage, of Elizabeth, addressed the Board. He provided the Board with an endorsement of the City's support for the redevelopment of the Oakwood Plaza project. He further stated that none of the existing tenants would be displaced. The project currently suffers from a high vacancy rate and the plan is to move the existing tenants into vacant apartments as they demolish and rebuilt the project. The first phase of the project will include senior apartments, the second phase will include affordable family rental housing and the third phase will include family housing.

Ms DellaVecchia thanked, Chief Financial Officer, Eileen Hawes, and the Capital Markets, Finance, Single-Family, and Property Management staff for compiling all of the requested information. She added that S & P expects to issue a report of this action next week, which she will share with the Board upon receipt.

Dorothy Blakeslee stated that not many housing finance agencies could get this credit rating on their own. Eileen Hawes stated that 26 housing agencies have ICR's and of the 26 Alaska is the only housing finance agency with a "AAA" rating and that there are between 10-12 housing finance agencies in the "AA" category.


